## HONORARY CHAIR FOR THE 2020 MOXIES GEORGETTE GÓMEZ



Council President Georgette Gómez of San Diego District 9 and 2018 MOXIE Honoree, is thrilled to return as the Honorary Chair for *The 2020 MOXIES*.

Councilmember Gómez was inaugurated to the San Diego City Council in 2016, becoming the first queer Chicana to serve on the San Diego City Council. She served in many roles, including chair of the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System, chair of the City Council's Smart Growth and Land Use Committee, and vice chair of the City Council's Select Committee on

Homelessness, and in December 2018 she was unanimously appointed President of the San Diego City Council. Councilmember Gómez has also been named as Woman of the Year in California's 80th Assembly District, and is currently running for Congress in California 53rd Congressional District.

Councilmember Gómez is a first generation Mexican American and the daughter of working class immigrants, who learned at an early age the importance of giving back to the community and helping those less fortunate. After attending Serra High School and graduating from San Diego State University, she dedicated her work to making her community a better place to live and raise a family. Councilmember Gómez lives in Azalea Park, a neighborhood of City Heights, with her two dogs, Canela and Frijolito.
